


Championing the Stockport Community

By sharing our time, skills, and resources, we help create positive pathways for individuals and strengthen the wider community.





SUPPORTING STUDENTS & YOUNG PEOPLE



- Delivered 3 hours of career talks and workshops at Stockport College and Aquinas Colleges, supporting 148 students.
- Ran webinars on finding work experience and part-time jobs for young people affected by the pandemic.
- Participated in a Speed Networking Day at Hazel Grove High School.
- Delivered a 1.5 hour CPD Training Event to educate local careers advisors at secondary schools and colleges in Stockport about local labour market insights (LMI).
- Launched the One Stockport Careers & Education Forum (OSCEF) to connect schools, employers, and training providers.

HELPING DISADVANTAGED JOBSEEKERS






- Partnered with Ingeus Restart Programme to run x5 sector-themed careers events for 114 long-term unemployed jobseekers, bringing together 15 employers offering over 100 jobs.
 Following the events, 86 job applications were processed within 3 days.
- Supported x17 over-50s jobseekers with a confidence and job search workshop in partnership with Stockport Homes Group. 11 of these have since progressed into part-time or full-time employment.

PROMOTING RECRUITMENT BEST PRACTICE



- Our partnership with Engage Grow Go (EGG) supported residents transitioning from homelessness back into work. Two individuals, Ben and James, received one-to-one careers coaching, CV support and referrals into training.
- Ben completed his SIA qualification and is now working evenings with Revolution de Cuba alongside warehouse shifts at Simon Charles Auctioneers.
- James achieved his Personal Training qualification and will soon start a work placement with Life Leisure.

CHAMPIONING THE STOCKPORT COMMUNITY



- The GR Team gave up 218 hours through our Employee Volunteer
 Scheme and their free time to volunteer weekly at local youth groups
 (Brownies, Scouts, and Richmond Rovers FC Wildcats).
- Our 3 Directors volunteered at Mission Christmas, packaging gifts and toys for disadvantaged children.
- As well as collecting donations from local businesses, we also donated £250 worth of gifts to support families across Greater Manchester.
