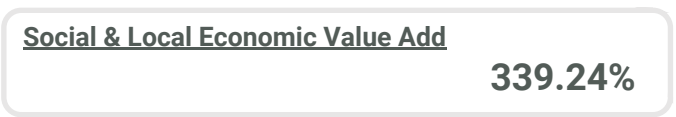

# Social and Local Economic Value

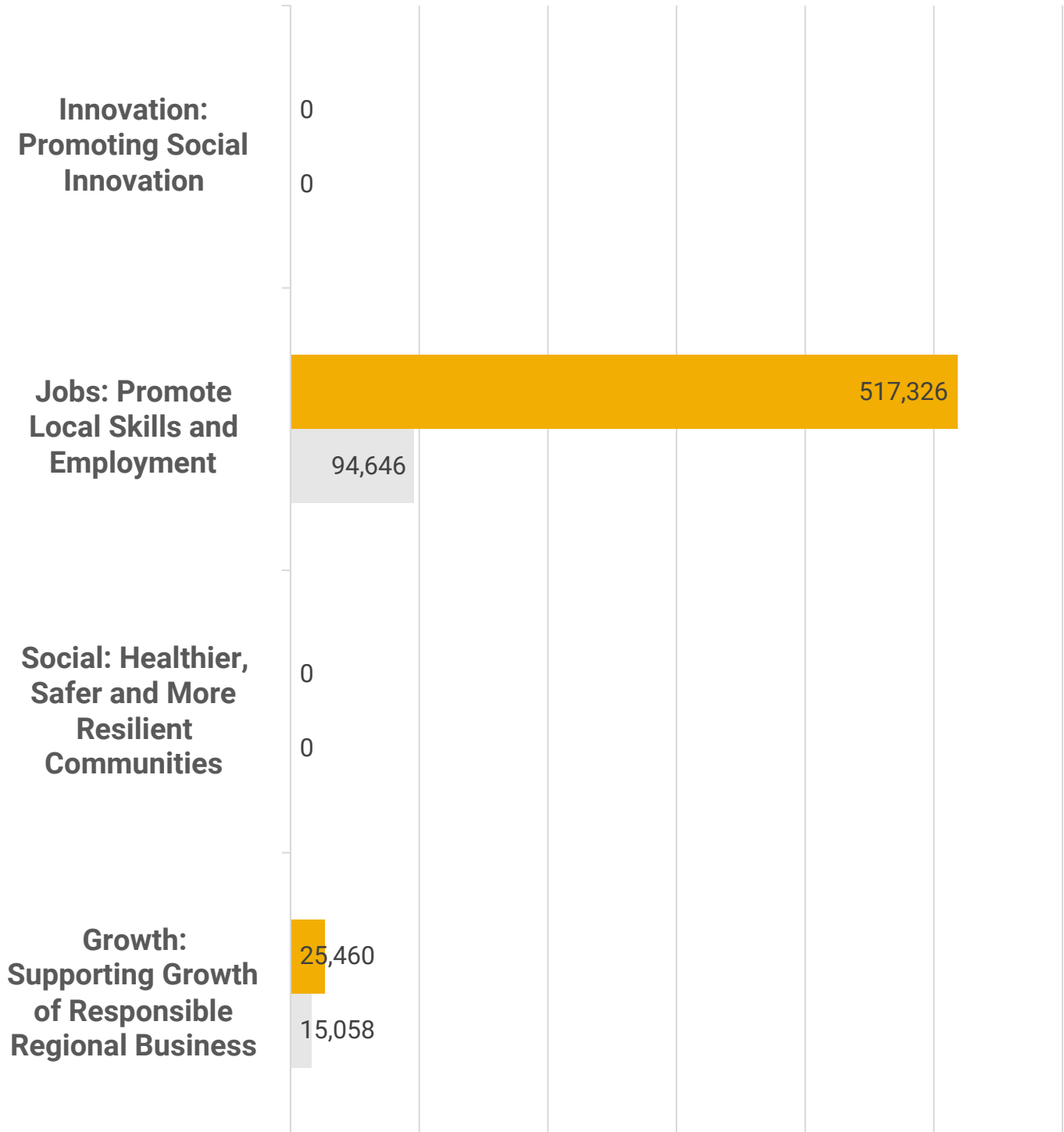
Social value refers to wider financial and non-financial impact, including the wellbeing of individuals and communities, social capital and the environment.
